ROAR is run by a small group of passionate people who believe that art is transformative and integral to the human experience. We believe that we can help the regeneration of Rotherham by supporting the local creative sector in its professional development and rising ambitions, whilst also embedding the arts in the social & economic environment, enabling the sector to thrive and creative practitioners to earn a living.

Rotherham Open Arts Renaissance is a not for profit limited company, operating as a membership based infrastructure organisation within the voluntary sector. We are funded as an Arts Council's National Portfolio Organisation.

WHAT WE DO:

We provide professional development support to our members in a myriad of ways. Through our membership process we try to learn about you and your own ambitions so we can tailor make our support to meet your specific needs.

We don't do things for you. Our aim is to help you gain the skills you want and need to achieve your chosen creative endeavour. We encourage collaborative working to help stretch and challenge your thinking. We help you formulate plans and proposals, apply for funding, organise exhibitions, create presentations, develop technical skills, build on marketing and promotion, as well as simply being here to talk ideas through.

You need space to be creative. We offer a range of studio spaces, as well as having our own resource space available for members to use, and we are always seeking new suitable areas. We also have a range of resources available such as a pottery studio, virtual reality set up and a laser cutter.

This is a Membership Organisation, and we work best when the communication flows both ways. We want your comments, feedback, suggestions and project ideas, and involvement in what we do; it makes the organisation richer for everyone. We need to know what you are doing so we can help promote you and your work.

It is also our aim to be developing paid work opportunities, whether that is community workshops, or more professional commissions.
